

2021 INTERNATIONAL FOLK ART MARKET Covid Safe Practices Plan for Participating Artists

TRAVEL

Precautions to take especially during the two weeks prior to travel to reduce risk of contracting Covid:

- **Limit close contact when possible with others outside of your household**
- **Wear a mask when in public**
- **Practice social distancing**
- **Wash hands with soap frequently for at least 20 seconds or use hand sanitizer especially after you have been in a public place**

Inbound Travel Requirements and Guidelines

All air passengers coming to the United States, including U.S. citizens, are required to have (1) a negative COVID test within 3 days of departure; or (2) documentation of recovery from COVID-19 infection and a letter from a licensed healthcare provider or public health official stating that the passenger has been cleared for travel (Documentation of Recovery).

Masks are required at all times while traveling.

Outbound Travel Requirements and Guidelines

Artists and assistants departing the US on international flights will need documentation of a negative (normal) COVID test within 3 days of boarding the flight. IFAM will arrange for these tests and documentation for all Artists leaving from Santa Fe at no cost to the Artists.. Artists departing from other U.S. states will need to make arrangements for testing on their own.

WHAT TO EXPECT UPON ARRIVAL IN NEW MEXICO

Mask Wearing

In New Mexico, everyone is required to wear a mask when in public except when drinking, eating, or under medical instruction.

IFAM will provide disposable masks to all artists as needed. If the artist prefers to wear a cloth mask, they are encouraged to wash the mask nightly or wear a new disposable mask underneath the cloth mask. Hand sanitizer will be available in dispensers throughout the Market.

Social Distancing

To practice social distancing, stay at least 6 feet (about 2 arm lengths) from other people who are not from your household in both indoor and outdoor spaces including while socializing outside of the Market hours.

Frequent Hand Washing

Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or use hand sanitizer especially after you have been in a public place, or after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing.

Cover Coughs and Sneezes

Always cover your mouth and nose with a tissue when you cough or sneeze or use the inside of your elbow and do not spit.

WHAT TO EXPECT AT THE MARKET

Accommodations

Artists are discouraged from sharing a hotel room with people they have not been traveling with. Artists should also refrain from socializing in their hotel room, and gather outdoors instead.

Transportation

Shuttles provided by IFAM will transport artists to the Market each morning and back to the Sage Inn in the evening. The shuttles will allow for social distancing.

Temperature and Symptom Checks

Upon arrival at the Market each day, a member of the Covid Safety Team will conduct a temperature and symptom check.

Cleaning and Disinfecting Frequently Touched Surfaces

Cleaning and disinfecting supplies will be available and Artists are encouraged to clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces.

Booth Layout and Occupancy

All artists will be given a 10'x10' booth with open space between booths.

Where possible, we encourage artists not to arrange garment racks in a way that encloses the booth and creates a micro-enclosure, limiting airflow.

To accommodate social distancing, the Market will allow a limited number of shoppers into the market, and will control that with timed entry.

IFAM leaves it up to the discretion of the artist to ask shoppers to wait to enter the booth until another shopper has stepped out of the booth.

Hospitality Room

The 2021 Market will combine artist and volunteer hospitality, which will be located in the Museum of Folk Art. Artists will be asked to gather their food and beverages and take them outdoors to eat. It is preferred that artists eat and drink in the designated outdoor areas, but we recognize that some may prefer to keep their food and drink in the booth. If doing so, please be conscious to replace your mask as soon as possible, and to sanitize your hands.

Meals

Lunches will be delivered to artists in their booths.

TESTING POSITIVE FOR COVID

Prior to Entering the US

If you test positive and are unable to board your flight into the U.S. please notify IFAM staff immediately.

While in Santa Fe

If artists have a temperature above 100.4 or are symptomatic when checking in at the Market, they will be tested for COVID and asked to follow the recommendations set by the New Mexico Department of Health.
